

# **Dominic Beattie**

### BIOGRAPHY

Dominic Beattie is an abstract painter, sculptor and furniture designer. His work is based on Modernist principles, specifically ideas of innovation and experimentation with abstraction as well as an emphasis on materials, techniques, and processes. His new works are a continuation of his exploration of colour and pattern.

Beattie has recently exhibited his work at The Saatchi Gallery, The Royal Academy, JGM Gallery and Fold Gallery. In 2015, he won the UK/Raine art prize for painting. In 2018, he curated the exhibition *Harder Edge (A Multigenerational Survey of Recent Abstraction)*, featuring 17 artists at The H Club, Covent Garden, which later toured to the Saatchi Gallery. In 2019, he co-curated *HABITAT: 24 artists making furniture or things that might be confused as furniture* at JGM Gallery.
