

# Katjarra Butler

b. 1946, Tjukurla WA, Australia

### BIOGRAPHY

Katjarra Butler is renowned for her wide luscious brush strokes and innovatve style. Her artistic process, often involving the application of numerous layers of paint, builds a fullness and depth distinctive in her work. Katjarra combines traditional symbols in a highly contemporary rendering of Ngaanyatjarra stories, culture, and landscape.

Katjarra was born near Tjukurla, WA (c 1946) and grew up in the bush, and lived a traditional nomadic life with her extended family group. She often paintings the waterholes at a sacred site near her home. Kuun is the name for yellow ochre. There is also a place very close to Kuun that Katjarra refers to as her home and it is one of her tjukurpa or dreaming which she paints. It is called Kuurrmankutja. This place is home to the two kuniya (python) dreaming. The other dreaming that she paints is Marrapinti.
